"The management of the affairs of the Branch shall be vested in the Executive Committee for which twenty members shall be elected following a General Election, at an Annual or Special General Meeting. Fourteen shall be members of the House of Commons. Six shall be members of the House of Lords. In both cases, their party membership should reflect as far as possible the then state of the parties in the relevant House, as advised by the respective Clerks. Every member of the Branch shall be eligible for election to the Executive Committee on the nomination of a single proposer who shall give written notice of the nomination together with the nominee's consent, to the Secretary seven clear days prior to the Annual General Meeting. All Members are eligible to vote. Not more than one vote may be cast in favour of any one candidate. If more than twenty votes are cast on one ballot paper, that paper will be invalid."

Voting will take place from 1230-1630 on Wednesday 16 October 20240 in the CPA Room.
